

## Future plans of IBIS remain open

**29.10.2016 Bad Godesberg. A decision about whether or not to give IBIS a green light for a secondary school was postponed. It was signaled that the administration wanted further talks with the school.**

Following a “no” vote by the Bonn School Committee but a positive sign from the city administration, Independent Bonn International School (IBIS) has reason to remain hopeful. IBIS had put forth a proposal for a secondary school and this was to be included on the agenda of the Bonn City Council for a Thursday evening meeting.

Instead, a committee which is at a higher level than the school committee, postponed discussion on the topic so it did not come up for a vote at the city council. According to administration, more talks should be held with the school.

IBIS is currently a primary school only. The Bonn school committee voted against a secondary IBIS school, saying another private international secondary school would lead to an oversupply. But that committee does not have a final say.
